WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT TOUR CITY OF LAS VEGAS WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FACILITY

The City of Las Vegas Water Pollution Control Facility (WPCF) is one of four major wastewater treatment plants located in the Las Vegas valley. The WPCF collects wastewater from the incorporated areas of Las Vegas and uses a variety of technologies to produce a high-quality effluent for discharge to the Las Vegas Wash which flows to Lake Mead, the main source of drinking water for the Las Vegas valley. The WPCF employs screening and grit removal technology as well enhanced primary sedimentation through the addition of ferric chloride. Primary effluent is further treated through two activated sludge processes where nitrification, denitrification, and biological phosphorus removal produce a high-quality secondary effluent. Tertiary treatment is media filtration with alum addition to sequester more phosphorus and disinfection is by sodium hypochlorite with sodium bisulfite for dichlorination before discharge. The facility operates some of the only anaerobic digesters in the valley used to generate electricity and continues to investigate co-gen applications to further sustainability initiatives.

The entire tour of the dam and power plant are centered on the importance of water – quantity, quality, and utility. A look into the wastewater facilities will emphasize the challenges faced by operating high volume but very seasonal facilities with significant variations in flows and demand while highlighting the legal challenges for compliance with those facilities as they share a common border between two states (CA & NV). Tour participants will leave with a better understanding of the importance of water and water quality for power generation and irrigation while gaining a perspective on the challenges in water and wastewater treatment for seasonal tourist destinations.
